The SC Center for Rural and Primary Healthcare is accepting proposals for our 2024 iCARE program. The Center invites proposals from diverse perspectives and disciplines that **seek to establish or expand outreach clinics to rural communities to address chronic illnesses**. Special consideration will be given to applications proposing to expand specialty services (i.e., endocrinology, cardiology, pulmonology).

- Any public institution of higher education in South Carolina
- South Carolina Rural Health Networks
- SC AccessHealth Networks
- Public or not-for-profit (501(c)3) organizations with an emphasis on health, rural health, or community services
- Direct providers of health care services
- State government agencies
- Must serve predominantly rural and/or underserved populations

## **Awards:**

This funding opportunity will fund multiple cooperative agreements in amounts up to \$300,000 per year. All projects will have a two-year project period, with the opportunity to renew extend to a third year pending the need for services in the community and

We fund direct costs only. Categories of allowable funding include, but is not limited to:

- Staff salary and fringe
- Medical equipment and supplies
- Capital equipment
- Health promotion and education materials and support
- Advertising and outreach related to services

## We do not fund:

- Applications that include covering the cost of patient copays and expenses
- Projects centered on one-touch events (health fairs, conferences, etc.)
- Salaries for personnel not directly involved with the project
- Equipment not directly related to the project
- Malpractice or insurance
